Rotary is dedicated to causes that build international relationships, improve lives, and create a better world to support our peace efforts and end polio forever.



Who is Oslo International Rotary Club?

Oslo International Rotary club (OIRC) is an English-speaking membership organization established on the 12th of February 2012. It aims at gathering Norwegians and Non-Norwegian nationals under the Rotary's main objective – service – in the community, in the workplace, and around the globe.

Our main projects are centred around youth work both abroad and locally to support and enhance the prospects of higher education, growth, understanding, tolerance, equality and culture exchange.

Membership & Cooperation alternatives

Any cooperation with OIRC can be one or a combination of several of the options listed hereby:

Corporation membership

Full OIRC Membership gives the company these options:

- ✓ have one or several employees at a meeting
- ✓ have the right to vote
- ✓ have access to the network of 1.4 mill Rotarians around the world
- ✓ have influence on the program and projects run by the club
- ✓ have the right & the duty to join one or more committees
- ✓ have own presentations and suggest events
- ✓ have the right to invite/suggest guests and speakers
- ✓ ...and more

Terms: Annual fee (subject to change): NOK 2 900,- (approx. 1/2 to the club, 1/4 to RI, and 1/4 divided by the Rotary District and TRF (The Rotary Foundation – mandatory Project contribution such as End Polio Now etc.)

The company should have one or more representatives (can be shared among i.e. three persons) attending up to 5 meetings either in person or digitally and learn about the OIRC objectives, structure and work before making up their mind to sign for a full membership.

Support programs options

- **General Support Partner:** A set donation at a set time agreed between the partners. OIRC has the right to use them to any of the projects they see fit.
- **Project Support Partner:** A set donation to support one or more of the OIRC Projects one or more times, agreed between the partners. The amount will be earmarked to the chosen project(s).
- **Student Sponsor Partner:** A Sponsor for one or more students at Sylhet Agricultural University, Bangladesh (SAU) for the time frame of each students Bachelor or Master Program, agreed between the partners. The company will have the opportunity to follow their “allocated” student(s) progress and communicate directly.

Other

- Option to be a dedicated supporter for the Fundraising and Networking events throughout the Rotary year (01 July – 30 June) Obligated to assist with venues, guests and content, as agreed with OIRC.

Advantages

The corporations with Social Entrepreneurship as part of their culture and program, will be able to showcase their contributions and results, making their global engagement as part of their profile and thereby strengthen their social and trust related image.

OIRC will strive to display and forefront their cooperations partners through their platforms and channels (such as Facebook, Instagram, Newsletters, etc.) whenever news or articles related to the chosen project/program are shared. In addition, Partner logo will be displayed on a dedicated, visible place on OIRC Website with information chosen by the Partner.
